Aurs Road Closure

A reminder that Aurs Road will be closed. East Renfrewshire Council announced that work to upgrade and improve Aurs Road was set to start on Monday 8th January 2024.

The Major road between Barrhead and Newton Mearns is set to be closed for 12 months. Aurs Road will be transformed - from a winding, single carriage road to a safer, straighter road with a new active travel route and stunning waterside promenade overlooking Balgray Reservoir.

Bereavement support payments

If your partner dies before you reach state pension age, you may be due bereavement support payments. While this help was previously only available if you were married or in a civil partnership, a recent law change means co-habiting parents are newly eligible and can get backdated payments worth £10,000s. But you only have until 8 February 2024 to claim this backdated support .

How to apply for backdated widowed parent's allowance

Backdated widowed parent's allowance can only be claimed by post.

If you're in England, Scotland or Wales, you can either download, print and complete a widowed parents allowance form, alternatively you can call the bereavement service helpline on 0800 151 2012 to request a form be posted to you, including in different formats, such as braille.

Good News Story

Single parent with two children attended bureau for assistance in applying for Child Disability Payment for her 11 year old son who had just had an autism diagnosis. Client worked part-time and was receiving universal credit. Welfare Adviser completed form and issued with supporting evidence provided. An award of Enhanced Rate for both Daily Living and Mobility components was achieved at £745.33 a month. This also allowed the client to apply for a Motability vehicle with benefit of free tax, insurance and recovery. The Child winter heating payment of £235.70 would automatically be paid due to the high rate award of CDP.

Additionally as the client was receiving UC she was now also eligible for the severely Disabled Child Component at £456.89 a month and also the Carer Component at £185.86 a month, while being exempt from the benefit cap.

The possibility of applying for Carers Allowance was discussed with the client as although this is deducted from the monthly amount of UC the £500 in automatic Scottish Carer Supplement is not.
